In each Class C1 and C2 by combination of points (applies only to final points after Carcass judging).

A.H George Memorial Trophy plus \$500 Prize Money for Champion Carcass.

V & V Walsh Prize for Runner-up Carcass.

Champion Ribbon awarded to Champion Pen of Three Lambs in any Class on show day.

The services of the **Brunswick Veterinary Services** are available if required.

PEN OF 3 LAMBS SUITABLE LOCAL TRADE

Class C1 Medium weight 18.0kg - 22.0kg (for carcass weights - live full points for weights 37kg-45kg)

Class C2 Heavy weight 22.1kg - 26.0kg (for carcass weights - live full points for weights 45kg-53kg)

1. Lambs to be penned on display by 9am Saturday 26th October.
2. Hoggets included will disqualify any entry and will not be accepted.
3. Points lost for overweight and underweight lambs.
4. Lambs will be judged on hoof on show day, then on the hook at V & V Walsh Abattoirs, Bunbury.
5. Prizes will be awarded at the Function on the Brunswick Showground.
6. Waybill must accompany each entry.
7. Brunswick Agricultural Society PIC number WHSG0019 to be included on the Waybill and Entry Form.
8. Farmers to have MSA number to be included on the Waybill and Entry Form.
9. On acceptance, all lambs become the property of the Brunswick Agricultural Society as Agents.
10. Points for each entry to be allotted at the discretion of the Judge as follows:

Live Judging	Points	Carcass Judging	Points
Liveweight	5	Carcass Weight	20
Condition Score	5	Fat Score	20
Preparation for Sale	5	Uniformity	20
Uniformity of Pen	5	Conformation	20
Total Maximum of Points	20	Total Maximum of Points	80

11. Competition results decided by aggregate live 20% of points and dressed carcass 80% of points.
12. After show, transport will be arranged to butchering company and will be purchased at market prices.
13. Net proceeds will be paid by the Brunswick Agricultural Society (Inc.).
14. Don't use spray mark that won't scour out.
