Rules and Conditions on Entry: *(Please read Entry Form carefully!)*

Entry Forms and Exhibits are to be left at the Secretary's Office **NO LATER** than **7pm Wednesday 23rd of October** or by arrangement with Steward. **Late entries may miss judging!**

(We take **no responsibility** on late postal mail. Please advise us via email if you are posting photos.)

All Amateur Photographers are eligible and welcome to enter the competition providing they do not earn a majority of income through photography.

In every class the photographs **must** have been taken by the exhibitor. **NO PHOTOS** may be exhibited two years in a row or again if it/they have previously won prizes at the Brunswick Show as they will be disqualified!

ALL ENTRIES: Must have their NAME of the Exhibitor, Section, Class and Contact Phone Number on the **BACK** of each **ENTRY!** **Children Exhibiting:** the same applies, but **Children must also have their Age on the back of each exhibit in Classes P09 & P10** to ensure Exhibits are in the correct age class.

Classes PSF1 & P01 - P10: photos must only have **MINOR image manipulation** by a computer program. **No Filters** and **No Major Editing** to alter their original photos or to exclude or enhance parts of the original photos. The use of cropping, brightness, contrast and hue adjustments are permitted.

Failure to comply with Brunswick Show photography rules and conditions: Entries may be deemed ineligible for judging and **disqualified**. No refund of entry fees will be given if this occurs.

MOUNTING ALL PHOTOS: photos are to be mounted on black/white or light grey THICK FIRM CARD.

(Mounting board or matting or 3mm Form Core is good. Try framers or art supply shops for this.)

NO Plywood/Hardwood/Masonite. NO Cardex (card isn't stiff enough to display photos)

NO coloured card/NO framed photos will be accepted.

ALL PHOTOS must be **FIRMLY ATTACHED** to mounting board use **plenty** of acid free double-sided tape. (We take **NO** responsibility for photos that are damaged/fall off/or get lost if not adhered correctly.) Ensure Photos/Mount Sizing is **CORRECT SIZE** as disqualification **WILL** occur if incorrect.

Maximum of **FOUR** entries per class is permitted per Exhibitor.

Minimum of **TWO** entries per class **required for Judging**

Collection of Exhibits:

Photography Entries **CANNOT** be collected before **5pm** Saturday 26th of October.

Exhibitors **MUST** bring their **exhibitors card** to collect their photography and Exhibitors **MUST NOT REMOVE ANY ENTRIES**. This is **STRICTLY** done by the Photography Steward and their assistants; they are the **ONLY** people to return photographs to Exhibitors.

Print/Mount Size: PLEASE READ AND CHECK BEFORE ENTERING

- **P08 (ONLY)** - Minimum Photo Print size 10cm x 15cm or Maximum Photo Print size 13cm x 18cm. This is **PER** photograph with (3 or 4) photos required for postcard display. When displaying postcard photos allow small spacing around each of the photographs.
- **P09/ P10** (Additional Photo Print size for Students and Children CLASSES ONLY) – Photo Print size 15cm x 20cm with a combine mount size Totalling 20cm x 30cm. P09 / P10 Can do bigger prints as below if want to.

Section P - Photography

The **BELOW PRINT/MOUNT SIZES** are for **ALL CLASSES** (with exception of P08) -

Photos can also be any size "In Between" the min & max combine print/mount measurements but **MUST NOT EXCEED!**

- **Minimum Photo Print size** - A4 20cm x 30cm with a combine mount size Totalling 28cm x 38cm.
- **Maximum Photo Print size** - A3 30cm x 45cm with a combine mount size Totalling 40cm x 50cm.

Please DO NOT EXCEED THE ABOVE COMBINE PRINT/MOUNT SIZE MEASUREMENTS!

(Any incorrect sized photographs **WILL** be Disqualified!)

Theme Descriptions: PLEASE READ: "Innovation in Agriculture" means we would like to see photographs of things that have innovated or improved the way we carry out agricultural duties today, as opposed to how we used to do these duties years ago. This could be anything from different vegetables/cropping production, milking, hay/silage production, watering, herd recording, fertiliser application, meat productions, harvesting grain/fruit/grapes etc. This is a very wide and rapidly developing area, that is everywhere around you. **BEFORE ENTERING** your photos ensure they are relevant to the Special Feature Subject
