Rules and Regulations for Trade Space Exhibitors

Please read carefully

Dogs are NOT permitted on the showground
(guide, hearing & show dogs excepted)

There is a kennel in the vicinity which will look after your dog. A Ranger will be on the grounds and any dog found will be removed. Recovery will be at your expense.

- Exhibitors are welcome to set up on Friday prior to show day.
- Gates are open at 6am on Saturday. Exhibitors to be set up by 8:30am. All exhibitors must stay until at least 5pm. No vehicle movement will be accepted on the showgrounds until after that time due to pedestrian safety.
- Electricity is available and must be booked and paid for, exhibitors must supply their own extension leads.
All leads must be TAGGED AND TESTED in accordance with current regulations.
- Available area for trade space is limited so some applications may be rejected, particularly food vendors where an oversupply of one food type is not desirable.
- Exhibitor's vehicles must be removed from the showgrounds by 8.30am on show day if they are not essential to sell/display your products.
- Exhibitors are responsible for supplying their own shelter and tables as required.
- Trade space is mostly on grass with some on bitumen depending on site location, exhibitors to provide own gazebo weights and pegs as required.
- The number of passes allocated is dependent on the area of space purchased.
Additional passes may be purchased from the society.
- All exhibitors must have at least one (1) workable fire extinguisher or fire blanket approved by the Health and Safety Regulations.
- It is the responsibility of exhibitors to arrange Public, Product and Workers Compensation Insurance to cover the liabilities in respect to all aspects of the activities on show day.
- The society has the right and authority to re-arrange spaces or move exhibitors to another location. Should the exhibitor set up in the wrong space, the exhibitor agrees to move to the proper location at exhibitor's own expense and without protest.

Prohibited Items:

Exhibitors must not sell, distribute, use or offer as prizes any of the following:

- Gas filled balloons unless the balloon is fitted with a non-conductive and rigid rod, drinking straw or weight
- Bows or arrows of any description
- Water pistols, cap guns, caps for cap guns or other similar items
- Guns or guns which can be converted to fire dangerous missiles or replica pistols or starting pistols
- Celluloid toys unless the exhibitor has a permit from the Health Department
- Chemical sprays, silly string, stage door streamers or similar spray projecting materials or pepper sprays
- Fireworks including sparklers
- Kites unless those kites are disassembled and packaged
- Any illegal or offensive item
- Laser pointers of any description
- No Smoking implements or paraphernalia, including imitation cigarettes e.g. 'Fags', bongos, drugs are not to be sold
- 'R' or 'X' rated videos, tapes, C.D's or cassettes

If the society at its sole discretion considers any item, goods, article, publication or material being exhibited, sold, distributed, used or offered as a prize by an exhibitor is unsuitable, objectionable or offensive, that exhibitor must after a request from the society to do so, immediately remove all items, goods, articles, publication or materials of that type from the showgrounds. Items referring to alcohol abuse, drug use, violence or that are sexually explicit or suggestive in nature are not permitted on the grounds.

- Tent pegs and star pickets must be capped with rubber protection
- Raffles / exhibitors must not sell raffle tickets in or outside the showground.
- Exhibitors must report promptly to the society any circumstances likely to be dangerous, cause any damage or danger to any person, their sites or in the showground.
- The society will not accept any responsibility for the protection of exhibits nor for any loss or damage how so ever caused.
- The exhibitor must accept responsibility for claims under the Workers Compensation Act or any other Act or Regulation related to their activities during the show.
